



# PRESIDENT'S LETTER

## HAPPY HOLIDAYS FROM OBG!

Dear Friends,

Where does the time go? It seems like just yesterday that I was sending my summer letter to all of you and yet here we are already in the midst of the busy holiday season. Since Thanksgiving is one of those holidays, it seems appropriate that I share with you



how thankful I am that OBG has the absolute best group of supporters and volunteers EVER. Without donations from all of you, hundreds of dogs a year would otherwise die. Without our volunteers, we would not be able to handle the intake of these dogs, find them foster homes, transport them to and from vet appointments, and raise the funds needed to care for them or handle the many, many administrative tasks involved in running a non-profit corporation. So, from the bottom of my heart, THANK YOU ALL!

Even with all the incredible support OBG receives, there never seems to be quite enough money or enough foster homes or enough volunteers. That's where all of you come in.

Typically, when I write to you I first review the dogs in our group with the goal of finding a few compelling stories to share. Those stories tend to jump out at me because they are so unique. Unfortunately, "unique" seems to be the new normal for OBG the past few months as you will see as you read through this letter.

Our fantastic intake team spends hours upon hours coordinating with shelters or owners surrendering their dogs to both gather information on the dogs that we are being asked to take and then to arrange their transport. It's a complicated and time-consuming process. Unfortunately, time is not always on our side. Recently, a vet who works with OBG called me asking for help with a three-year-old dog, **Little Lady**. Little Lady's owner was at her office and wanted to euthanize Little Lady because of really bad skin issues that they could not get under control. Little Lady was clearly feeling miserable and the owners felt they had no other choice but to end her suffering.

The vet was desperately searching for a way to avoid having to euthanize this poor little girl, so she called OBG. We had to make an immediate intake decision with very little information. Ultimately, a decision was made based on two criteria: (1) her age and (2) her exceptional temperament. So, OBG accepted Little Lady for intake and her life was saved. The next day I saw the pictures of Little Lady and I sat down and cried.

Usually, it takes weeks to get an appointment with a veterinary dermatologist, but in this case, the vet emailed pictures to the dermatologist and he agreed to see Little Lady the very next day. She is now undergoing aggressive treatment for her skin while we still wait for some test results.

The good news is she is making remarkable progress every day both in clearing up her skin condition and putting on weight – bananas are a favorite food of hers and volunteers are seeing that she gets plenty of them to eat! As you can see by her current picture, she is already looking 100% better. Her treatment is costing OBG thousands of dollars, but we think she's worth it, don't you?

There was another case recently when a quick decision had to be made. It was the end of the day when I received a call about a two-year-old dog named **Clancy** who had just arrived at OBG that same day. OBG's intake vet immediately discovered that **Clancy had four broken and dislocated foot bones**.

Our vet faxed Clancy's x-ray results to a specialist who said that if Clancy were to have any hope of recovering full use of his leg, surgery had to be done the very next morning. The vet was so concerned that she offered to personally drive Clancy to the specialist's office, but first they needed authorization to do surgery that would cost \$4000.

There was no time to think about it – a decision had to be made immediately and his surgery was authorized. Clancy is still recovering and we are pleased to report his prognosis is excellent.

Little Lady and Clancy are just two of the dogs that required expensive and extensive medical care. Here are some of the many other dogs helped by OBG recently at great financial expense:

- Eighteen-month-old **Sammy** had knee surgery to correct a luxating patella **so he would no longer be in pain when he walked.**
- Three-year-old **Jack** was given a new lease on life after having surgery to fix a chronic problem with a **hip joint that was completely dislocated.** The surgeon believes that Jack had experienced some sort of trauma early in his life that had caused the injury.
- Two-year-old **Shadow** was born with a **birth defect called patent ductus arteriosis (PDA)** which is a condition whereby he had two vessels in the heart that should have closed at birth, but did not. He had to have surgery to close those vessels. His prognosis since surgery is excellent. Without surgery, this condition would have killed him.
- Nine-year-old **Ginger needed mast cell surgery to survive.** She also needed extensive ear treatment.
- Ten-year-old **Scooter** and eight-year-old **Lezlee** were **almost blind** when they came to OBG and needed immediate **bilateral cataract surgeries to restore their vision.** Scooter also had bald patches all over his body and received extensive care for his skin issues.



The dogs referenced above cost OBG between \$2,000 and \$4,000 each for their specialized care. These costs were in addition to the money OBG routinely spends on foster dogs for kennel care and routine vetting.

So many dogs in this world suffer unbelievable neglect and abuse. Only a small percentage of these dogs are lucky enough to be given a second chance at life like the ones saved by OBG. Then there are the dogs that were in loving homes, but their owners could no longer keep them and

had to give them up. After all these dogs have been through, whether it's abuse, neglect or suffering the loss of a family they loved, we believe each dog that comes to OBG deserves the best possible care we can give them, don't you?

OBG has been very fortunate to have had the funds to provide the care needed not only for the dogs listed in this letter, but for every dog that we have accepted for intake. The problem is that money doesn't last forever and as I write this letter, OBG's funds are very tight.



**Currently, we have sweet Pucci who needs ear ablation surgery to end the constant suffering she has due to severe pain in her ear.** Pucci's prior owner loved her very much, but could not afford the surgery. He gave her the greatest gift of all by turning her over to rescue so she could get the surgery she desperately needs. Her surgery will cost OBG thousands of dollars. We need to double our fundraising efforts so that Pucci and the next group of dogs with health issues like Little Lady, Clancy, Shadow, Ginger, Scooter, Lezlee and Jack will be able to receive the medical care they need to live long, happy, pain free lives. Won't you please make a donation to help Pucci and all the dogs that OBG saves?

I will end this letter with a confession to all of you. I'm very worried about 2014. Did you know that a large portion of OBG's yearly income comes from the government's Combined Federal Campaign (CFC)? 2013 CFC donations were much less than prior years and we are concerned that they will decrease even further in 2014. Not only has it been a difficult year for government workers, but also the fall CFC campaign was temporarily halted during the government shut down. That means we have to work extra hard to find other ways to raise the money outside of CFC. That includes asking all of you to please consider making whatever size donation to OBG you can afford.

As I always tell people, when it comes to saving the lives of homeless dogs, I'm not too proud to beg. So, this is ME begging YOU to please help so OBG can continue to give the dogs we save the care they deserve! The dogs are counting on you.
